
Streamlines Versus Trajectories METR 3123 Atmospheric Dynamics II [figures from Lugt 1979]

An atmosphere otherwise at rest is disturbed by a body (cylinder/car) moving through it. The body (moving from right to left) and associated <u>streamlines</u> are shown below at two different times:



For this same case we can consider the <u>trajectory</u> of an air parcel that was initially in front of the body, and ends up behind the body:
